

EMOJI DESIGN CHALLENGE

Today we communicate using emojis to express ideas and emotions. New emojis are being added to our visual vocabulary every day.

Your last challenge for this art rotation is to design an ORIGINAL emoji!

It can be a facial expression, object, or symbol. The design has to be original and unique to you. Your emoji design CANNOT already exist (this is why this is a CHALLENGE!)

In addition to your emoji design drawing, write up a two-sentence artist statement, explaining what your emoji is and what it expresses.

Your drawing should be at a minimum, six inches by six inches, but it can be bigger. Use whatever paper and drawing materials you have at home. Ideally, your emoji should be colored in and as bold as possible! I (Ms. Altshuler, your art teacher) will participate in this challenge and will share with you my own emoji design on our last day of class, next Monday, April 13th.

Your design is due by 11:59 on Monday April 13th.
