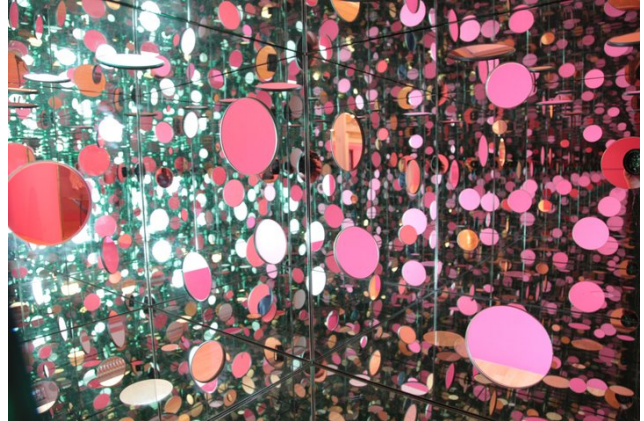

Your task is to create a collage using the **SAME** repeated shape cut out of an assortment of materials that you have collected. Your collage should have a minimum of **twenty** pieces of your shape cut out of a variety of materials. You can vary how big or small your shape is, but the shape has to be repeated and overlapped throughout the composition. You can glue this collage onto any paper you have at home. When you finish, take a photo of your collage and email me the photo, along with the responses to the questions above.
